

EARLY ADMISSION: SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Applicants who took and passed the February 2021 examination and who have been recommended for admission may participate in the May 7th main admission ceremony that will be held remotely.

Admission prior to the May 7th ceremony is permitted only if there are special circumstances that warrant early admission. Early admission may occur between April 21st and April 30th, 2021.

To request early admission, you must submit a written request stating why it will create a hardship if you are not admitted before May 7th. Circumstances where exceptions have been granted in the past include active duty military deployment or hardship to an employer. Please include a letter from your employer if the request is based on employer hardship.

The Board of Law Examiners will process your request as soon as possible but please be advised that it could take up to 48 hours to hear back. Please plan accordingly.

Persons who are admitted prior to the May 7th ceremony may not participate in that event.
